Article 34. LIBRARY FACULTY DEVELOPMENT DAYS

~~The Director of the Library will continue the past practices and procedures of development days for tenure-track library faculty at the assistant professor rank. Each tenure-track assistant professor in the Library will be entitled to five development days per academic year of the Agreement for the purpose of research, writing, and other activities directly related to the criteria for tenure and promotion. These days will be scheduled to accommodate staffing in the Library.~~

Faculty members with indefinite tenure or annual tenure appointments in the Library may take up to five (5) Development Days per academic year for the purpose of research, writing, and other activities directly related to the criteria for tenure and promotion, as expressed in the faculty member's scholarly agenda, and as reviewed and discussed collectively as part of the overall scholarly agenda of Library faculty members. These days will be scheduled to accommodate staffing needs of the Library. This provision supersedes all past practices with regards to Library faculty development days and other days away from the Library, except for vacation, sick and other leaves specifically provided for by applicable University-wide rules or policies or by an express term of this Agreement.

THIS PROPOSAL DOES NOT COVER ANY CONTRACTUAL PROVISIONS OTHER THAN THOSE SPECIFICALLY IDENTIFIED HEREIN AND THE UNIVERSITY RESERVES THE RIGHT TO MAKE PROPOSALS CONCERNING ALL OTHER CONTRACTUAL PROVISIONS.
