Authorization to Deduct Member Dues

Both members and non-members represented by PSU-AAUP contribute to the financial support of our union. The payroll deduction is the same whether or not you choose to join. (For members, it appears on the pay stub as "Member Dues," and for non-members, who pay fair share fees authorized by the collective bargaining agreement, it appears as "Fair Share"). Signing this form does not change the amount you pay. It does give you the right to vote, so you can elect representatives, voice your views and shape our union's priorities.

The deduction of member dues requires authorization through this form pursuant to Oregon Revised Statute 295.055. By signing this form, I hereby authorize the monthly deduction of my member dues to the Portland State University Chapter of the American Association of University Professors. The amount of the deduction is based on my salary and PSU-AAUP status, and is calculated by the PSU-AAUP office and the Payroll office. The monthly deduction will continue until I provide written notification to the Payroll Office.

Regular Dues cover PSU-AAUP membership and membership in the National AAUP, the AAUP-Collective Bargaining Congress (CBC), and the Oregon Conference of the AAUP (AAUP-OR). Regular member dues are 1.052% as of March 1, 2017. Dues increase year to cover increases in dues imposed by our affiliates.
