Subject: 2017-2018 EMERITI PARKING PERMIT REQUEST

Dear Professor Emeritus,

For the 2017-2018 fiscal year, you may request a free commuter parking permit valid at specific locations on the PSU Campus. Please review the instructions and terms below. If you currently have an Emeritus permit, please note that it will expire on June 30, 2017, and you must renew if you would like to continue parking on campus via this program.

The Emeriti Faculty Parking Permit is your use only and is valid only when displayed on a vehicle that you have registered with PSU Transportation & Parking Services (multiple vehicles may be registered). Only one active permit may be issued per requesting emeritus member. Emeritus Parking Permits are free of charge to any Emeritus volunteer, so long as they are not currently employed by PSU.

Emeriti Parking Permits are valid in non-reserved Permit Parking and Hourly Parking spaces at the following locations:

- Parking Structure One (1872 SW Broadway)
- Parking Structure Two (1724 SW Broadway)
- Parking Structure Three (1631 SW 12th Ave)
- Art Building Parking Lot (2000 SW 5th Ave)
- Market Center Building Parking Garage – B1 Level Only (1600 SW 4th Ave)

Emeriti Parking Permit restrictions:

- Emeriti Permits are not valid in Reserved Parking Spaces, with the exception "F/S" faculty/staff reserved spaces
- Emeriti Permits are not valid in pedestrian zones, restricted areas, or no parking zones
- Permit holders must adhere to any posted time restrictions, including at loading zones
- Permit holders must display a state-issued disabled parking placard to use disabled parking spaces on campus
- Emeriti Permits are not valid for overnight parking

New permits will be sent by mail beginning June 15, 2017. Once your request is received, your permit will be mailed to the address provided on your renewal form. Your 2017-2018 Emeriti Parking Permit will be valid until June 30, 2018.
