WORRIED ABOUT FALL TERM 2020?

Fall term is fast approaching, and even though PSU will be mostly online, many caregivers of school-aged children don't know what will be happening in the K-12 realm come September.



PSU-AAUP calls on the University to develop robust support for caregivers during this unprecedented pandemic. PSU must continue to accommodate caregivers through adjustments in expectations for service, research, and evaluation timelines -- **for both faculty and APs.**

PSU-AAUP wants to remind you that there is still relief for caregivers. You may request a reduced or full-time FTE reduction using a combination of your **accrued sick leave, FFCRA coverage, expanded FMLA coverage**, and the **PSU-AAUP Sick Leave Bank**. You may also request a **flexible work schedule** to alleviate some of the challenges of working remotely while caring for children.



PSU-AAUP strongly suggests that if you are considering taking advantage of this option for Fall 2020, that you begin talking to Human Resources (covid19.benefits@pdx.edu) and your supervisor now to give plenty of time to make arrangements.
