**Emeriti Parking Permits are valid in all non-reserved Permit Parking spaces or Hourly Parking spaces at the following locations:**

- Parking Structure One (1872 SW Broadway)
- Parking Structure Two (1724 SW Broadway)
- Parking Structure Three (1631 SW 12th Ave)
- Art Building Parking Lot (2000 SW 5th Ave)
- Shattuck Hall Parking Lot (1955 SW Broadway)
- University Place Hotel Parking Lot (310 SW Lincoln St)
- Market Center Building Parking Garage – B1 Level Only (1600 SW 4th Ave)

**Emeriti Parking Permits are not valid in Reserved Parking Spaces (with the exception of reserved spaces marked "F/S" for faculty/staff). These permits are also not valid in pedestrian zones, restricted areas, no parking zones, or loading zones beyond the time limit for loading. Emeriti Permits may only be used in disabled parking spaces when a state-issued disabled parking placard is also present and displayed.**
